

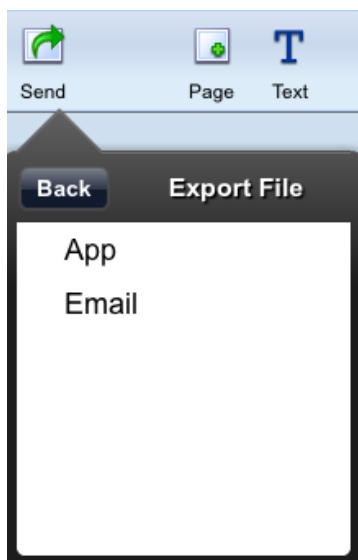


Moving Pixie files between iPads and Desktop computers using Dropbox or Google Drive

Send files from iPad to cloud storage

Tap the **Send** button on the Pixie app toolbar.

Tap **Export File** and tap **App**.



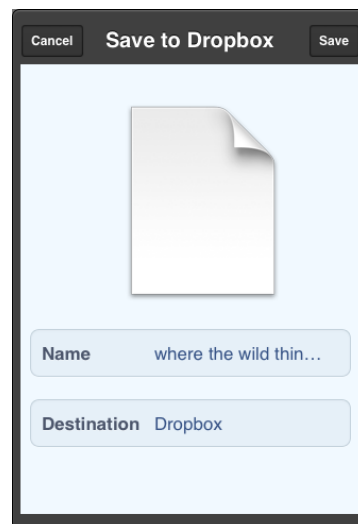
You will see a progress bar while Pixie gathers the resources needed.

The Send options will show cloud storage apps you have installed on your device.



Tap the **Dropbox** icon to save to Dropbox.

The iPad will switch to the Dropbox app.

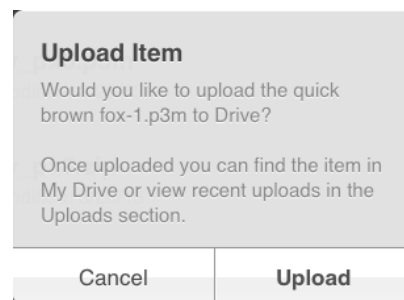


Tap the **Destination** button to navigate to other folders in your Dropbox account.

Tap the **Save** button once you have the correct location for your file.

Tap the **Google Drive** icon to save to Google Drive.

You will see a dialog asking you to upload the file.



Tap the **Upload** button.



Moving Pixie files between iPads and PCs using cloud storage

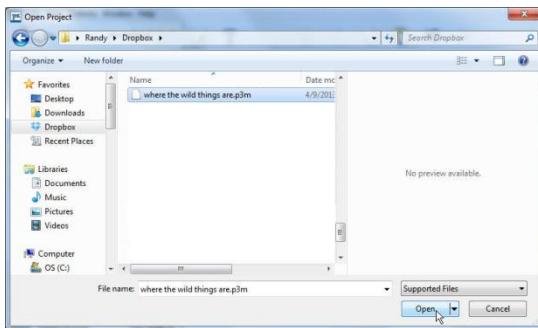
Opening files stored in the cloud on PCs

You must have cloud storage drives connect and be using Pixie 3.1 or higher.

Launch Pixie (3.1 or higher). Go to the **File** menu and choose **Open**.

Navigate to the GoogleDrive or DropBox location where you've saved your Pixie mobile file and select it.

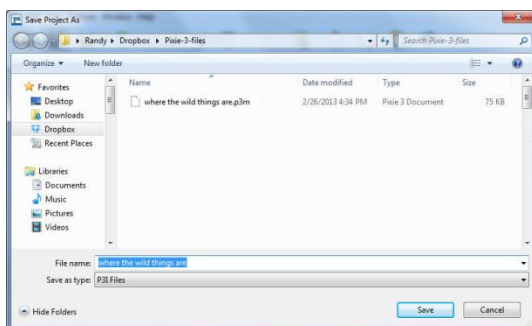


Click the **Open** button.

Send files from PCs to cloud storage

Click the **Save** button on the toolbar.

Navigate to your cloud storage, such as Dropbox or GoogleDrive.

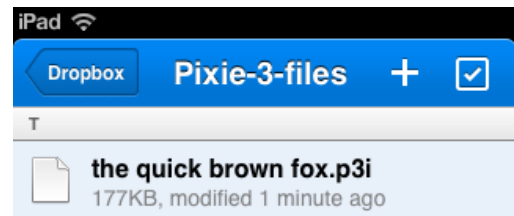


Click the **Save** button.

Opening files stored in the cloud on iPads

Open the cloud storage app on the iPad.

Find the Pixie file you want to open and tap to select it.



Tap the **Open in** button.



Tap **Open in Pixie**.

The file will open in the Pixie app for iPad.
